Opportunities for Irrigation water in Balliang? Luke Wilson from Western Water

7.30pm, Thursday, 20th April, 2017,

Balliang Hall, Balliang-Bacchus Marsh Road (opposite CFA)

Western Water is currently seeking interest from local property owners and businesses interested in utilising recycled water.



Western Water manages recycled water from seven recycled water plants across the region from Bacchus Marsh and Melton up to Woodend and Lancefield.

Our speaker: Luke Wilson, Renewable Resources Project Manager, Western Water.

Luke writes that recycled water is currently used for many varying purposes including sports oval and golf course irrigation, irrigation of crops and fodder, irrigation of orchards and vineyards. Recycled water is also used in some residential areas for toilets and garden watering.

Western water is investigating opportunities to utilise **additional recycled water** that is rapidly increasing with urban growth in our region. Opportunities to supply recycled water outside our existing recycled water network are being considered.

Please come along to our next Landcare Meeting to hear about this exciting possible development. Western Water wants to know what local residents and businesses think about this opportunity!

We are also hoping to hear about recent trials conducted by the Balliang Food and Fibre Network.
